This means hospitals and critical access hospitals accredited by DNV are deemed to meet or exceed the applicable Medicare conditions of participation ("CoPs") and are eligible to receive payment from Medicare for the provision of hospital services to Medicare beneficiaries. DNV's unique accreditation program focuses on continuous quality improvement and integrates the Medicare CoPs with ISO 9001 quality management standards. Our attorneys are acquainted with this newest hospital accreditation program, and the firm is committed to supporting attorneys wishing to obtain certification as DNV quality surveyors.
