#### HHS BEGINS DISTRIBUTION OF PAYMENTS TO HIGH COVID-19 ADMISSIONS HOSPITALS AND RURAL PROVIDERS

■ HHS announced it is processing payments today to hospitals with large numbers of COVID-19 inpatient admissions through April 10, 2020 and to rural providers from the Provider Relief Fund.

### HRSA ISSUES COVID-19 UNINSURED PROGRAM PORTAL RESOURCES

#### FROM THE FDA

■ The FDA issued an emergency use authorization for the investigational antiviral drug remdesivir for the treatment of suspected or laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 in adults and children hospitalized with severe disease.

#### CDC CREATES COVID-19 TOOLS FOR HOSPITAL INFORMATION

■ The CDC launched a COVID-19 Module, the National Healthcare Safety Network, which is a data dashboard of information collected such as inpatient and intensive care unit bed occupation of participating hospitals.

#### **CONGRESSIONAL OUTLOOK**

■ The Senate will resume its session on Monday and the House remains in recess until an unknown date. There are no coronavirus-related bills to be voted on next week.
